

- Always wear your shirt! (if you come to something without one on we'll ask you to purchase one for \$10.00 or go home and get it.)
- (A) Handle the pets with care and responsibility.
- Be aware of the animal's behavior.
- Be Polite!

- Keep your hands and feet to yourself.
- Always hold the leash of the animal you are holding correctly. (Wrap the leash around your wrist and hand.)
- Don't stick hands in cages.
- No teasing either people or pets.
- Tell an adult volunteer that you are leaving an event
- Mo texting while volunteering for AEAR unless it is to contact your parent or caretaker.
- (No phone calls (except parents or care takers).
- No gum chewing.
- No eating out front during an event.
- Don't socialize too much with each other.
- Be mindful of the animal's space.
- Think safety! Don't move too close to an animal too fast.
- Make sure all the animals collars are tight enough that the collar can't slip over the animal's neck and they get loose.
- Don't be negative to the people or animals around you.
- Keep dogs apart from each other. Our rule is always six inches apart from each other.
- Don't put food or drinks on tables, they could spill an ruin valuable items.
- No running, shouting, or pushing.
